

# Tryouts FAQ

## **Tryouts have always started the Tuesday after Memorial Day, why the change?**

A rule change was passed at the 2016 FYSA AGM to allow for tryouts to start earlier. All clubs state wide may now hold tryouts starting April 1st. Clubs will be able to run and hold open tryouts as they see fit as long as it's within the FYSA provided guidelines. To view those guidelines please [CLICK HERE](#).

## **Who is FYSA?**

Florida Youth Soccer Association is the governing body who sanction leagues, clubs, coaches and players in the state. FYSA provide the rules and regulations we adhere to.

## **What happens to my roster spot on my current team starting April 1st?**

Nothing changes for the remainder of the season which is the day after Memorial Day.

It is imperative to note that no players will be dropped from the current team roster for the remainder of the 2016/17 season. All teams should be aware of their league and tournament calendar for the remainder of the season and their existing team will remain in place until the last ball is kicked by each team in late May.

## **Does this mean that there will be no tryouts in May or June?**

FYSA affiliate clubs (PC United included) may still hold tryouts in May / early June (dates TBA).

## **Will all roster spots be offered in April?**

Players may be notified by the coach at any point in the tryout process of placement if selected. The number of roster spots still 'open' after the April tryout dates will vary on a team by team basis.
